**Instructions for obtaining or renewing a Food Handler / Health card**

**Step 1:** Pick up a specimen (STOOL) container kit from the front desk at Myrah Keating Smith Community Health Center or Morris De Castro Clinic between the hours of **8:00 am to 5:00 pm**.

**Collection instructions:**

Collect a walnut size specimen in the **green top tube provided in your kit**, without toilet debris.

Tube must be labelled with:

- Your Name
- Date of birth
- Date and time collected
- Refrigerate specimen until is delivered

**DO NOT PUT THIS PAPER BACK  
IN THE BAG, IT HAS THE REST  
OF YOUR INSTRUCTIONS!!**

NOTE:

**Specimens will be accepted only in the provided tube.**

**DO NOT HOLD SPECIMEN OVER 24 HOURS**

**Step 2:** Bring your specimen and register for lab at Myrah Keating Community Health Center. Specimens are accepted from **Monday - Friday from 8:00 am to 11:30 am only**. (With exception of Government holidays).

**Lab fee is \$25.00 Cash only and due at time of drop off.**

**Step 3:**

Register at Morris De Castro Clinic **Monday - Friday between 8:30 am and 10:30 am**.

(With exception of Gov. Holidays).

**The following items will be required to register at De Castro Clinic:**

- Government issued ID
- **ORIGINAL Social Security Card (COPIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED)**
- Receipt from Myrah Keating Smith Community Health Center
- **\$30.00 Cash Only**
- Proof of Physical address and mailing address

Lab results are sent directly to Morris De Castro Clinic. Allow 3 Business days for processing.

Cards are issued at Morris De Castro Clinic **Monday - Friday from 1:30 pm to 3:30 pm**.

**Registration at Morris De Castro must be completed before card can be issued.**
